## Joint press statement by BAR's Europe calling on EU-member States to lift travel restrictions

A joint message to the media was sent by all BAR's across Europe advocating a fast and consistent approach regarding the restart of travel and air traffic within the EU and with third countries. The BARs involved are criticizing the current uncoordinated situation and point out that, from a technical point of view, the prerequisites for the necessary harmonization are already in place. ## Relief measures from Schiphol Airport

Please [click here](#) to download a letter from the CFO of Amsterdam Schiphol Airport, Robert Carsouw in which a continued relief package for Q3 2021 is being presented.

Schiphol decided the following:

- For the period 1 July 2021 – 30 September 2021, a discount of 5% on the Landing & Take-off charges will be applicable.
- From 1 July 2021 – 30 September 2021 the payment terms of all airport charges will be as follows:
  - Invoices paid within 30 days will be rewarded with a discount of 2%.
  - Invoices paid within 45 days will be rewarded with a discount of 1%.
  - When not applying for discounts, payment terms remain at 60 days.
- As announced in our letter for final setting of airport charges 2021, Schiphol has decided not to invoice the charges increase of 5% provided for 2021 (effective April 1, 2021), for a period of 6 months.
