JetBlue opens routes from New York and Boston to Amsterdam and joins BARIN

We are very happy to announce that JetBlue has decided to join the ranks of BARIN. Welcome! JetBlue will commence daily services from New York to Amsterdam 29th August, followed three weeks later by daily services from Boston to Amsterdam. All services will be operated by state-of-the-art and very fuel-efficient Airbus A321neo LR aircraft. This generation aircraft type burns less fuel, produces lower emission of CO₂ etc. and are much quieter than the previous generation aircraft.
