The Minister for Nature and Nitrogen Policy, Mrs. Christianne van der Wal, granted Schiphol a nature permit last week. A significant step as getting that permit means that Schiphol is now complying with current law and regulations. Schiphol received its permit for 440.000 to a maximum of 500.000 flights, depending on the outcome of the Balanced Approach, which is currently being studied by the European Commission.

One may ask the question why it is still necessary for next Summer to decrease the number of air traffic movements with 12.400 less than this year. Isn't this a premature decision? Brussels still has an opinion to formulate or may request additional information which definitely will take time.

It seems like a confusing set of events which is not helping our industry, neither contributing to a positive image of our country outside our own borders. It's about time that all stakeholders define the future of sustainable aviation together instead of each stakeholder following a different path.

The *Duurzame Luchtvaarttafel* (Sustainable Aviation Table) under the leadership of Lodewijk Asscher is the platform in which we should come together to combine our efforts, our expertise and our ambitions to reduce our carbon footprint to eventually zero. BARIN is committed to take her responsibility.

ACNL issued Capacity Declaration for Summer 2024

On 28th September Airport Coordination Netherlands published the Capacity Declaration for Summer 2024. Despite the fact that the Balanced Approach procedure at the European Commission is still ongoing and we are still awaiting a verdict in the Cassation on the announced reduction of air traffic movements the Capacity Declaration shows a huge reduction of capacity compared to Summer 2023.
