Amsterdam Airport Schiphol announces changes in Target-off-Block-Times rule

Last week, Schiphol announced a change in the TOBT-rules effective 6 February 2024 in an effort to reduce the instability in the aircraft turn-around process. The Working Group CDM has decided to implement a technical change where TOBT-updates smaller than 5 minutes are rejected by the system.
