IATA, BARIN and ACN sent a letter on CO₂-ceiling to Minister Harbers

As a follow-up of the joint letter by IATA, BARIN and ACN sent in June 2022 already, we have sent another letter to the Minister of Infrastructure and Watermanagement Mr. Mark Harbers, to re-emphasize our concerns of the individual Dutch initiative to introduce a national CO₂-ceiling for Aviation.

Following the different information sessions organized by the Ministry, we would like to reiterate our strong opposition to this proposal, which in our view, goes in the opposite direction of all the international and European commitments to tackle aviation CO₂ emissions. It contradicts the principles of CORSIA (Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation), the EU ETS (European Union Emissions Trading System), and the broader goals outlined in the RefuelEU Aviation initiative.
