How Dutch politics work

For those who are not that familiar with Dutch politics, we give a brief outline of how it works. The national elections for the House of Representatives (Tweede Kamer) will be held on October 29th. People can choose between a variety of parties and contrary to e.g. the USA we do not have a mainstream 2 party system. There are 150 seats in the House to be divided between 15 to 20 parties. For a new to be formed Cabinet it is most desirable to form a coalition with a number of parties that together hold a majority of seats (76) in the House in order to have new legislation passed. With so many parties getting a piece of the pie, a coalition cabinet has always been a given in The Netherlands. The other remaining parties will form the Opposition.
